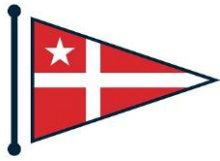


Amendments to the NOTICE OF RACE



SANTA BARBARA YACHT CLUB
SIR THOMAS LIPTON STAR TROPHY &
DISTRICT 5 ISCYRA BLUE STAR CHAMPIONSHIP
July 14 & 15, 2018



Organizing Authority:

International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (ISCYRA) District 5,
and the Santa Barbara Yacht Club (SBYC)

Rule 1.3, 1.4, and 1.5 are added:

- 1.3 The regatta shall qualify as a Blue Star District 5 Championship (ISCYRA rule 23.5.3) open to all members of all Fleets and to Isolated Members. The Championship is an 'Open District Championship'. Honor Awards for the Event and qualifications via the Event are only granted to the winners which are either Members of the organizing District or participating as Isolated Members.
- 1.4 ISCYRA Rule 34.3.7, Format C, is changed to allow a minimum distance of a leg to be less than one nautical mile.
- 1.5 The last sentence of ISCYRA Rule 34.2.7, Format C, is changed to "No more than 4 races per day".
- 1.5 Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn penalty per ISCYRA rule 35.5

Rule 2.5 and 2.6 are added:

- 2.5 For those boats competing for the District 5 ISCYRA Blue Star Championship, the following apply:
 - a. The boat must be eligible per ISCYRA rule 21.
 - b. The skipper and crew must meet the membership requirement of ISCYRA rule 26.
 - c. The crew weight must comply with ISCYRA rule 31.1.3. Weigh-in times and locations are detailed below in the 'Schedule of Events'.
 - d. Per ISCYRA rule 31.2.2, each boat must carry two approved personal flotation devices, one paddle or oar, and one line of 8mm minimum diameter and minimum length of 20m.
 - e. The boat must have a measurement certificate per ISCYRA rule 33.
- 2.6 Boats wishing to enter the District 5 ISCYRA Blue Star Championship must elect to do so on their online entry form.

Rule 3 is deleted and replaced with:

3.2 Number of Races: Seven races are scheduled with no more than four races to be sailed on any one day. This changes ISCYRA rule 34.3.7, Format C.

Rule 8 is deleted and replaced with:

- 8.1 The Sir Thomas Lipton Star Regatta will be scored as one class with all competitors included in the scoring. Competitors who meet the eligibility requirements and elected to sail in the ISCYRA District 5 Blue Star Championship will be scored separately in addition to being included in the Sir Thomas Lipton Star Regatta scoring.
- 8.2 The low-point scoring system of Appendix A will apply except that when fewer than six races have been completed, a boat’s series score will be the sum of her races scores.
- 8.3 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

Rule 12 is added:

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

The race committee will monitor and make transmissions over VHF channel 71 to competitors and support boats.
