

of art, from classical to contemporary.

Santa Barbara Maritime Museum - Learn about the region's maritime history

through exhibits, artifacts, and interactive displays.

Lotusland - Spectacular botanical garden featuring rare and exotic plants, sculptures, and themed gardens.

WINERIES AND BREWERIES

Figueroa Mountain Brewing Co. - Local brewery with a variety of craft beers on tap, including IPAs, lagers, and stouts.

Third Window Brewing - Cozy brewery in the Funk Zone offering a rotating selection of small-batch beers and artisanal snacks.

Telegraph Brewing Co. - Innovative brewery specializing in Belgian-inspired ales and sour beers, with a spacious tasting room.

M. Special Brewing Company - Family-owned brewery with a lively taproom, known for their creative brews and friendly atmosphere.

Brass Bear Brewing & Bistro - Up-and-coming brewery and restaurant in downtown Santa Barbara, offering a unique selection of house-made beers and elevated pub fare.
