AMENDMENTS TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Organizing Authority for the 2024 Shalhoob Women's Invitational & Women's Skipper Championship will be:
The Santa Barbara Yacht Club (SBYC), 130 Harbor Way, Santa Barbara, CA 93109

The notation [NP] in a *rule* means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that *rule*. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

The notation [DP] in a *rule* means that the penalty for a breach of a *rule* may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. Sailing Instruction 11 is deleted and replaced with:

11 THE COURSE

Courses will be taken from 'Amended Attachment A - Course Chart'. The course for the race will be hailed on VHF channel 71 and posted on placards on the SBYC Upper Deck.

2. Sailing Instruction 13 is deleted and replaced with:

13 THE START

- 13.1 The Start line will be between 'G' mark (as shown on the SBYC Course Chart) and an orange tetrahedron as shown in 'Amended Attachment A Course Chart'.
- 13.2 Races will be started as described in RRS 26.
- 13.3 The class flag will be numeral pennant 1.
- 13.4 As a courtesy, the race committee may attempt to hail on course side boats on the designated VHF channel. Failure of a boat to see or hear her recall notification shall not be grounds for redress. A boat's position in the sequence of hailed numbers or broadcast numbers shall not be grounds for redress.


3. Sailing Instruction 15 is deleted and replaced with:

15 THE FINISH


The finish line will be between 'G' mark (as shown on the SBYC Course Chart) and an orange tetrahedron as shown in Attachment A – Course Chart.
