

Dr. Frank Cline Jr., 1968 1917-2004

A graduate of the University of Pennsylvania, Frank was a well-known physician throughout the county. He served as a U.S. Naval medical officer with the Second Marine Division in the South Pacific during World War II. In Santa Barbara, Frank was the communicable disease officer for the Santa Barbara County Department of Health. As commodore, he was an asset to the club: an efficient administrator who added dignity and prestige to his office, and a firm believer in the value of good public relations. His well-maintained Henkley 41-foot sloop Jou Jou participated in local races and cruised in Mexican waters.
