

## Stanley M. Darrow 1973

1921-1988

Raised in Santa Barbara, Stan was a junior skipper in the Yacht Club back in the 1930s when the clubhouse was on the pier, and his father, Stanley Arthur Darrow, was a member. Like many of the Yacht Club's top skippers, he sailed in the Flattie Fleet for a number of years before joining the larger fleets. Stan had a long list of wins to his credit and skippered in many ocean racing events, including one Trans-Pac. He raced the Nugget, which was built by Ken Urton (Commodore 1957). He placed third in the first US NS14 Nationals and won the Geary-18 National Championship in Texas in 1963.
