

**Paul D. Kolyn, 1960** 1917-2000

Paul was a prominent local attorney. He became an enthusiastic sailor, first owning a clipper and later stepping up to a 30-foot Knarr sloop, which he sailed in the arbitrary handicap class. This boat was similar in size to a PC but had no power, and at times it took some doing to sail it in and out of the slip. In 1959, Paul and Joe Jordon took the Caspers Trophy Opening Day PHRF with the Nesea. In 1964, Paul won the Potter Trophy in Ocean Racing Class B with Kari. Paul was an accomplished violinist and devoted much time to this avocation, which later took precedence over his sailing activities.
